One of India's top engineering schools has restricted Internet access in its boarding houses, saying addiction to surfing, gaming and blogging was affecting students' performance, making them lonely and even suicidal(有自杀倾向的).

Authorities at the best Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) in Mumbai said students had stopped socializing and many were late for morning classes or slept through them. "Now, a student doesn't even know who lives two doors away from him because he is so busy on the Internet," said Prakash Gopalan, dean of Student Affairs. "The old dormitory culture of companionship and socializing among students is gone. This is not healthy in our opinion."

IIT-Mumbai, with about 5,000 students, is one of seven IITs across India which are considered to be among the finest engineering schools in the world. They are also a talent pool for global technology giants. But their hard courses, tough competition and lonely campus lifestyle have taken an effect on students. Depressive and dysfunctional (不正常的) lifestyles are known to be common among IIT students, and at least nine have committed suicide in the past five years. Students have unlimited free Internet access in their boarding houses to help them in their studies, but many also use it to surf, chat, download movies and music, blog and for gaming.

"Starting Monday, Internet access will be banned between 11 p.m. and 12:30 p.m. at IIT-Mumbai's 13 boarding buildings to encourage students to sleep early and to try and force them out of their shells,"Gopalan Said. But the move has not gone down well with students who say they hate their lives being regulated. "Now they will say we need to listen to a lullaby (摇篮曲) to go to sleep,"said Rajiv, an electronics student. 1456

West Virginia---Public schools are using a dance video game to help get students in shape. In these schools, students are often told to turn off their video games and get some exercise. The schools have found a new way for their students to work out while playing a new video game. West Virginia is one of the heaviest states in the country. About half of its fifth-graders are considered to be overweight, and their parents are worried about that. To get them moving on a healthier path, the state's public schools are using a video game called "Dance Dance Revolution".

To use the game, players should stand on a special mat in front of a TV screen. Following arrows on the screen, players must move their feet to the specific symbols on the mat. Players must move quickly, touching symbols on the mat at just the right time. With each song, they get more exercise. Some health care experts hope that the schools can get children to change their behavior at a young age in this way and grow up to be healthy and active adults.

West Virginia is ranked among the top three heaviest states. About a third of West Virginians are considered to be obese. Even more are considered to be overweight. Extra weight can lead to serious health problems such as high blood pressure, diabetes(, some cancers, and many other health issues.

"One out of three children born in West Virginia today will have diabetes by the time they grow up," said Nidia Henderson, a manager for the public employees' insurance(保险) program. "That's a terrible thing and not acceptable."

All of West Virginia's 157 middle schools are using the video game. School officials hope that all public schools in the state will use the game within the next three years. However, officials emphasize that the game is not meant to <u>substitute</u> physical education and health classes. People appear to be born to compute. Children's numerical skills develop so early that it is easy to imagine an internal clock of mathematical maturity guiding their growth. Not long after learning to walk and talk, they can set the table with impress accuracy---one knife, one spoon, one fork, for each of the five chairs. Soon they know to place five knives, spoons and forks on the table and, a bit later, this amounts to fifteen pieces of silverware. Having thus mastered addition, they move on to subtraction. It seems almost reasonable to expect that if a child were secluded on a desert island at birth and retrieved ($\pm \pi \square \pi$)seven years later, he or she could enter a second-grade mathematics class without any serious problems of intellectual adjustment.

Of course, the truth is not so simple. This century, the work of cognitive psychologists (认知心理学家) has shown the subtle(微妙的) forms of daily learning on which intellectual progress depends. Children were observed as they slowly grasped---or, as the case might be, bumped into---the concepts that adults take for granted, as they refused, for instance, to admit that quantity is unchanged as water pours from a short stout glass into a tall thin one. Psychologists have since stated that young children, asked to count the pencils in a pile, readily report the number of blue or red pencils, but must be coaxed (哄劝) into finding the total. Such studies have suggested that mathematics is mastered gradually, and with effort. They have also suggested that the very concept of abstract numbers---the idea of a oneness, a threeness that applies to any class of objects and is a prerequisite(先决条件) for doing anything more mathematically demanding than setting a table-----is itself far from innate (天生的). 1492
