A

London's newest skyscraper is called the Shard and it cost about 430 million pounds in construction. At a height of almost 310 meters, it is the tallest building in Europe. The Shard has completely changed the appearance of London. However, not everyone agrees that it is a change for the better.

The Shard was designed by the famous Italian architect Renzo Piano. When he began designing the Shard for London, Piano desired a very tall building that looked like a spire (尖顶). He wanted the glass surfaces to reflect the sky and the city. With the sides of the building irregular, the building has an unusual shape—a very thin, sharp piece of broken glass. And that is how the building got the name: the Shard. Piano says that the spire shape of the Shard is part of a great London tradition, reminding him of the spires of the churches of London or the tall masts (桅杆) of the ships that were once on the river Thames.

The Shard has 87 floors. At the top there is an observatory. At the moment the building is empty, but eventually there will be a five-star hotel and also top quality restaurants, apartments and offices.

Before construction work began, a lot of people didn't welcome the Shard though the plans were approved. Now they are still unhappy about the Shard. Some critics say that such a tall skyscraper might be fantastic in a city like New York, but not in London. They say that the best thing about the Shard is its spire shape. But that is the only thing. There is no decoration, only flat surfaces. The Egyptians did that 4,500 years ago. They also think the Shard is too huge for London, which destroys the beauty of the city.

Other critics don't agree to what the Shard seems to represent, saying that the Shard implies how London is becoming more unequal. Only very rich people can afford to purchase the expensive private apartments and enjoy the luxury. But the people who live near the Shard are

among the poorest in London. So the Shard seems a symbol of the division in society between the very wealthy and the poverty-stricken.

The Shard now dominates the London skyline. It is not certain, however, that ordinary London citizens will ever accept it as a valuable addition to the city.

C

Great country life in Walden(瓦尔登湖)

Walden, or Life in the Woods, Henry Thoreau’s most famous work, is popular with people who want a kind of peaceful life in modern society. He spent two years and two months in the woods of Walden. The following is one of his experiences.

“As I drew a still fresher soil about the rows with my hoe (锄头), I disturbed the ashes of unrecorded nations who in ancient years lived under these heavens...When my hoe tinkled (发出叮当声) against the stones, that music echoed to the woods and the sky, and was an accompaniment to my labor to the woods and the sky, and was an immeasurable crop. It was no longer the beans that I hoed, nor I that hoed beans; and I remembered with as much pity as pride, if I remembered at all, my acquaintances who had gone to the city to attend the operas.

The nighthawk (夜鹰) hovered overhead in the sunny afternoons—for I sometimes made a day of it—like a small thing in the eye, or in heaven’s eye, falling from time to time with a swoop and a sound as if the heavens were rent...

Small birds that fill the air and lay their eggs on the ground on bare sand or rocks on the top of hills, where few have found them, are graceful and slender like ripples caught up from the pond, as leaves are raised by the wind to float in the heavens...

Or sometimes I watched a pair of hen-hawks circling high in the sky, alternately soaring and descending, approaching, and leaving one another, as if they were the expression of my thoughts.

Or I was attracted by the passage of wild pigeons from this wood to that, with a slight shaking windowing sound and carrier haste...

When I paused to lean on my hoe, these sounds and sights I heard and saw were anywhere in the row, a part of the great entertainment which the country offers.”

For those who are tired doing the laundry, Samsung has found an answer: a washing machine that can tell you when your laundry is done via a smartphone app(application).

Strange though it may seem—"my wife already does that" was a common response among attendees viewing the device when it was introduced at the Consumer Electronics Show (CES) this week —Samsung is just one of many appliance makers racing to install (安装) a large number of internet-connected features in machines in an effort to make them "smart".

Last year, it was a refrigerator that tweeted(发出鸣叫). This year, it's Wi-Fi-enabled laundry machines and fridges that can tell you when your groceries are going bad.

The washers and dryers, available starting in the spring, connect to any smartphone through a downloadable application. The phone can then be used as a remote control, so the machines can be turned on and off while their owners are at work or on the bus.

Samsung says it's not just something new—the app connection actually has some practical uses.

"If you started to dry clothes in the morning and forgot to take them out, you can go to your phone and restart your dryer for the time when you come home, so your clothes are refreshed and ready to go," said spokesperson Amy Schmidt.

The company also says that with electricity rate (电价)varying depending on the time of day, more control over when the machines are used can help save money.

Perhaps, but what they will probably really accomplish is what all good technologies do—enable laziness. Rather than getting up to check on whether the laundry is done, users will monitor it on their phones while watching TV.
