William Sydney Porter was born in Greensboro, America. When William was three, his mother died, and later he
lived with his grandmother and aunt. He was interested in reading. But at the age of fifteen he had to leave school
and made money for the family. He did a lot of jobs before he was a writer. These experiences were good to his
writing. Later, he moved to Austin, Texas, and then got married when he was twenty.

In 1901, he changed his name into O. Henry. The next year he moved to New York. Henry's first book, Cabbages
and Kings, came out (出版) in 1904. The second, The Four Million, came out two years later.
On June 3, 1908, he was seriously ill. Two days later, he died, and he was only 48 years old at that time. O. Henry
wrote ten books and over six hundred short stories in his life. He was a great writer.
